





**8 out of 10** Filipinos have a positive outlook for the Philippines under President Bongbong Marcos administration.



**7 out of 10** Filipinos are looking forward for improvement in their daily lives under President Bongbong Marcos administration.



Despite the negative allegations and news that the family Marcos received **6 out 10** Filipinos fully trust President Bongbong Marcos will lead a good administration in the Philippines.




Q4. Gaano ka nagtitiwala o hindi nagtitiwala kay Bongbong Marcos bilang Presidente ng Pilipinas??

**8 out 10** Filipinos are looking forward to at least a good performance that President Bongbong Marcos will make in the next one hundred days in the Philippines.




Q10. Sa iyong palagay, ano ang magiging performance ni BBM sa unang 100 araw niya bilang bagong Pangulo ng Pilipinas?


**6 out 10** Filipinos are fully confident that President Bongbong Marcos will have the right solution to address the current challenges in the Philippines.

Meanwhile low confidence reasons range from **no concrete plans, may bahid na korapsyon, magnanakaw, etc.**





Top – 2 rank that Filipinos would like to address are **Economy (2.37) and Agriculture (3.14)**. These relates to the country's current challenge for work availability and rise of price in goods.

Top – 2 reasons for issues that needs to be addressed are **Trabaho (24%) and Mataas na Bilihin (16%)**. These are directed to the current challenges in the country under basic necessities due to the lack of jobs and high inflation of the price of goods.



**8 out 10** Filipinos believes that President Bongbong Marcos can address the high inflation rate in the Philippines.







While a few **15.6%** doesn't follow the protocols.





**8 out 10** Filipinos agree that the program Build, Build, Build should to be continued for the benefit of the Filipinos.



**9 out 10** Filipinos agree to improve and strengthen independent foreign policy to improve foreign relations with the consideration for interest and welfare of the Filipinos.



**9 out of 10** Filipinos still agree to continue the advocate of the previous administration to fight the illegal use and distribution of drugs in the country.



# SUMMARY



## SUMMARY

- At least **60%** of the Filipinos on average have a positive outlook on the performance and what President Bongbong Marcos can bring to the Philippines.
- **ECONOMIC and AGRICULTURE** are the top priorities that the current administration needs to address, these are inline with the current challenges; **lack of jobs and price of goods** that is affecting majority of the Filipinos.
- **79%** are satisfied with the action plans of the government with Covid-19 but **56%** are still worried on resuming face to face classes.
- At least **8 out of 10 Filipinos** agrees on continuing both previous government platform and the new government plans for the Philippines.
